CONSERVATION CORNER

At the intersection of nature and neighborhoods. The southeast corner of Kingshighway and Vandeventer continues to grow as a conservation hub.

Brightside's headquarters, adjacent to our Demonstration Garden, now includes the **Missouri Department of Conservation** (MDC). Just two doors down from Brightside at 4640 Shenandoah is MDC's **Howard Wood St. Louis Urban Outreach Office**.

A delightful dedication ceremony brought regional partners and MDC experts from across the state to Brightside's Demonstration Garden, including MDC **Director Sara Parker Pauley**.



MDC's collaborative space serves as a central hub for staff with expertise in urban wildlife, fish, forestry and conservation education. Free MDC publications on a variety of conservation topics are available for visitors — in the MDC office and at Brightside. Hunting and fishing licenses, as well as Conservation Calendars, are also available for purchase.

But wait - there's more! We also welcome **Forest ReLeaf of Missouri** to our conservation corner. Once renovations are complete, Forest ReLeaf's main office will be located between MDC and Brightside at 4642 Shenandoah.

We were all invigorated by special guest speaker, **Dave Tylka!** He shared his wealth of knowledge as a biologist and professor on *Landscaping for Bees, Butterflies and Other Pollinators*.

GOOD NEIGHBORS

This year's Neighbors Naturescaping grant cycle kicked off with a special presentation and breakfast at the St. Louis Urban Gardening Symposium. It was a resounding success. More than 60 neighbors participated representing 40 different neighborhoods and organizations. We're excited to see what beautification projects these groups have in store.

Neighbors Naturescaping is a small grant program through which neighborhood groups and community organizations can request up to \$1,500 in native plants, shrubs, trees and grasses to enhance a public space in St. Louis City. This program is supported in part by the Missouri Department of Conservation, Forest ReLeaf and the City of St. Louis.



KEEPING ST. LOUIS CLEAN

Brightside's graffiti eradication team has been hard at work. Over the past year, the team has removed or painted over graffiti from more than 225,000 square feet. How big is that room you have been putting off painting??
